Requirements:

- The application must be completed and submitted to the LCHS guidance department by March 1.
- Three letters of recommendation must accompany the application.
- Applicant must be a current LCHS senior in good standing with at least a 2.8 grade point average.
- Consideration in choosing a recipient will be based on financial need, character, potential, and grade point average.
- Priority shall be given to relatives of Haley in years when there is a senior graduating.

Amount:

- The Scholarship shall be no more than \$1000.00 per year disbursed in equal payments each semester.

The scholarship will be awarded at the Annual Senior Awards Program by a family member (if available).

The Committee to determine the recipient of the scholarship shall be as follows: principal, guidance counselor, and a member of Haley's family.

The scholarship will be paid to the college of the student's choice when the USD 506 Board of Education office receives proof of enrollment and the students meet all other requirements.

Failure of the applicant to claim the scholarship award by November 1 of the year following the applicant's high school graduation will render the scholarship offer null and void.

Labette County USD 506 shall serve as custodian of the scholarship award. The Scholarship will continue as long as funds are available.
