

The 506 Foundation Scholarship

The 506 Foundation Inc. has designated a scholarship on behalf of the community and patrons of Labette County. This scholarship has been created to assist Labette County High School students and/or graduates with furthering their education and achieving their academic goals.

1. The applicant must be a current LCHS senior in good standing or LCHS graduate.
2. The applicant must express intent to attend college or technical school.
3. The applicant must complete the formal scholarship application form and submit documentation to the LCHS guidance department by March 1st.
4. The 506 Foundation shall serve as custodian of the scholarship award. Amount to be awarded is \$500 annually.
5. The scholarship shall be awarded at the annual Senior Awards Assembly and recognized at the Alumni Banquet.
6. The 506 Foundation shall, with any input offered by the donor, select the appropriate committee of not less than three members to determine the recipient(s) of the scholarship. Their decision shall be final.
7. Recipient selection will be based upon the following:
 - Financial Need
 - Academics
 - Extra-curricular Activities
 - Autobiography
 - Community Involvement
 - Area of Study
8. Scholarship payment shall be made to the recipient and the college when evidence of enrollment, attendance, and payment of fees has been presented to the 506 Foundation Treasurer located at the USD 506 District Office.
9. Failure to claim the scholarship award by November 1 of the award year will render the scholarship offer null and void.
