

Clifford and Brenda Morris – Environmental and Safety Management (ESM) Scholarship

My parents, Calvin and Margie Morris, encouraged me to attend college and provided me with financial assistance to attend. My parents also introduced me to the field of safety management, and I've had an exciting and rewarding career in this field. The purpose of this scholarship is to encourage Labette County High School (LCHS) students to choose a course of study in ESM and to financially assist these students with college attendance costs.

Guidelines are as follows:

1. The applicant must be a current LCHS senior in good standing.
2. The applicant must attend college at Pittsburg State University (PSU) and major in ESM.
3. The applicant must complete the formal scholarship application form and submit documentation to the LCHS guidance department by March 1st.
4. The 506 Foundation shall serve as custodian of the scholarship award.
5. The scholarship shall be awarded at the annual LCHS Senior Awards Assembly. Amount to be awarded, if any, will be determined annually by selection committee.
6. The committee to determine the recipient(s) of the scholarship shall be comprised of the donor (Clifford and/or Brenda Morris or other person designated by the donor), the LCHS Principal or other person designated by the LCHS Principal, and one LCHS guidance counselor. Their decision shall be final.
7. Recipient selection will be based upon the following:
 - Financial Need
 - Academics
 - Extra-curricular Activities
 - Autobiography
 - Community Involvement
 - Area of Study - ESM at PSU
8. Scholarship payment shall be made to the recipient(s) and PSU when evidence of enrollment, attendance, and payment of fees has been presented to the 506 Foundation Treasurer located at the USD 506 District Office.
9. Failure to claim the scholarship award by November 1 of the award year will render the scholarship offer null and void.
