

**The Traxson Family Memorial Scholarship
Honoring LC Alum “Norman Traxson”**

Norman Traxson graduated from LCCHS in 1952. Norman was always a great supporter of Labette County’s school programs. He and his wife Edith raised their children, who are also alumni; Ron in ‘74, Deb in ‘77, Tim in ‘79 & Greg in ’83. He was proud they benefited from what Labette County schools had to offer. The scholarship’s emphasis is based on Norman’s 27 years as an instructor at Southeast Kansas Vo-Tech as a machinist, and his family’s careers in education through his children and grandchildren.

Criteria to apply:

- Applicant must be a current LCHS senior in good standing.
- Applicant must express intent to attend college pursuing a career in education or a technical or trade school.
- The applicant must complete the formal scholarship application form and submit documentation to the LCHS guidance office by March 1st.

If awarded the scholarship:

The 506 Foundation shall serve as custodian of the scholarship award. The amount to be awarded is \$400 annually.

The scholarship will be awarded at the annual Alumni Banquet.

The committee to determine the recipient of this scholarship will be determined by the 506 Foundation.

Recipient selection will be based upon the following:

1. Financial Need
2. Autobiography
3. Community Involvement
4. Extra-curricular activities
5. Area of study: Education or Technical Trade

Scholarship payment shall be made to the recipient and the college when evidence of enrollment, attendance and payment of fees has been presented to the 506 Foundation Treasurer located at the USD 506 District Office.

Failure to claim the scholarship by November 1st of the award year will render the scholarship null and void.
