We will have **enrollment on Monday August 5th from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm and Tuesday, August 6th from 7:00 am to 1:00 pm.** Please come in on one of these dates so we can get our bus routes, reduced lunch forms, and any other paper work taken care of. We will also take care of book, lunch, and extra milk fees at this time. We will not be able to give credit on extra milk; this must be paid for in advance.
