Math: We are continuing to work on division facts 0-12. Practicing addition, subtraction, and multiplication is still important so they can become automatic with the answers. Also please keep reminding them about "attention to detail" during math and labeling their answers.

Reading: The biggest thing you can do at home is to have your child read out loud nightly. Reading out loud helps them develop fluency skills that we work on in class. Also, read to your child from time to time. this is a great way to model what fluency looks like.

Science: We will continue the first chapter about the engineering process and how to solve problems. This has a big emphasis on fixing failures. The kids are learning that failing is part of the process and must be learned from.

STEAM Lab: The kids recently did a straw rocket activity that required teamwork and engineering. We will continue to utilize this time for engineering/solving different problems that relate to our science lessons.
