## Curriculum

Science – Sixth grade just finished taking a test over Lessons 1 & 2, Unit 1 this past week. These tests are in a very different format than what students are familiar with from the old curriculum. The questions require them to analyze and apply what we have learned. Our next lesson is about the water cycle. Students will complete a project and have a "mini" test over this lesson.

Social Studies – We will be completing our chapter over the first human societies early this week. Their test will be later this week. They will have notes, worksheets from the chapter, and a study guide to help them prepare for the test.

Math – Sixth graders continue to work on decimals and fractions in Math. They will have three more Wednesday quizzes before Christmas. Please remind them to study. We will be having a test over adding and subtracting decimals before Christmas.

Language Arts – 6th - We will continue to read short stories focusing on figurative language. We will begin to incorporate figurative language into our writing as well.
