Brave Families,

I am eager to continue my educational career, in USD 506, as principal of Bartlett Grade School. I am looking forward to working closely with parents, community members, students, and staff to ensure the best education possible for all students. We hope to see all of the students at 8:30 on August 27th for the first half-day of school.

With governors mandate in place, it is important to note that masks will be required by all people on school grounds and at any school activity. This is something that will be enforced district-wide in an effort to keep all students, staff, and patrons as safe as possible.

We will have enrollment on Wednesday, August 5th from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm and Thursday, August 6th from 7:00 am to 1:00 pm. At this time we will ask you to choose which plan you would like your student enrolled in. The district reopening plan can be found at <a href="https://www.usd506.org">www.usd506.org</a>. Please come in on one of these dates so we can get our bus routes, reduced lunch forms, and any other paperwork taken care of. We will also take care of book, lunch, and extra milk fees at this time. Families will receive a discount for enrolling on these dates. Please try to limit the number of people attending enrollment so that social distancing can be achieved. Also, masks will be required for all people attending enrollment.

Our "Back to School Night" will not be in person this year. On the week of August 31-September 4th each teacher will set up a time to have virtual back to school night. Students will bring their devices home that afternoon so that all families have a device to log on with. We hope these meetings will help you become more informed about what your child will be doing at school and on remote learning Wednesdays.

All athletes and cheerleaders will need to have a completed physical on file before they are cleared to practice. Labette Health and Local Community Physician (Kathy Swearingen) have chosen to make appointments for physicals so we can do them in a controlled environment. These will be free of charge to the student – but you MUST make an appointment, MUST have a parent signature on physical form, MUST have Patient Information Sheet filled out and signed.
