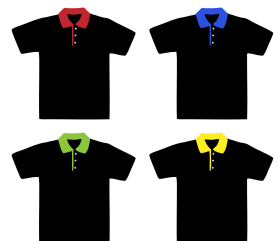

Start: Southside /Front side of AGS
Turn left on Virginia to 5th turn east/right
To Ness turn right on 7th
7th to Wabash turn right to 6th
Left on 6th to Huston
Left to Cemetery turn around head north on Huston
Turn right /east on 6th end in front of school

1 mile Fun Run

Start: Southside/Front side of AGS
Turn left on Virginia to 5th turn east/right
To Ness, turn right on 7th
7th to Wabash turn right on Illinois ave
End in the front of AGS
