We are learning:

Language Arts: We are working through a unit called Revolution. This unit will have stories both fiction and nonfiction that are historical. Through this unit we will work on cause and effect, fact and opinion, and sequence of events. On the grammar side, we will be learning about subject and object pronouns, verb tenses, and regular and irregular verbs. IXL are also assigned weekly.

Math: We will start in Unit 5 for the month of November. With that unit, we will focus on multiplying and dividing decimals and whole numbers. IXL will also be assigned each week. Please continue working with your child to memorize their math facts 0-12.

Science: Our new unit will focus on energy and matter in ecosystems. We will be discussing food webs and talking about how energy is transferred.

Social Studies: We are working through a unit about colonists settling in North America. We will discuss both Spanish and English colonies in North America, as well as the pilgrims and puritans in New England. Students also have weekly Daily Geography due every Friday.
