We are learning:

Language Arts: We are finishing our unit on Revolution. This unit has had stories both fiction and nonfiction that are historical. Our new unit will be about the power of storytelling. With this unit, we will have many stories that cause us to use our imagination. Through this unit, we will learn about dialogue, facts, and illustrations, as well as author's purpose.
