We were busy in the month of September. The class earned their first caught doing good celebration! We finished our first chapter in Math. Now, we should be able to recognize, write, and count 0-5. In Reading the class has been working hard on letter recognition, sounds, and writing. The letters we have already covered are Mm, Nn, and Ff. This week we will be focusing on Vv and Pp. Our apple theme activities have covered a lot of different subjects like Math, Reading, Science, Writing, Social Studies, and Art. Last week we watched the video of Johnny Appleseed and had applesauce for our snack time to finish the unit.

The October topics will be fire safety, pumpkins, fall changes, skeletons - Health, and Red Ribbon activities for drug awareness. In Math we are learning about comparing numbers (greater than, less than, and equal to) in chapter two. Also, we will continue to work on reading, counting, and writing to 20. For Reading, letters and sounds will still be a priority along with literature and grammar. Sight words will be a main focus starting this month too. We will be introduced to developmental writing to express ideas at our grade level.
